Description: This service is located at 16 Barlink Road, Waulkmill, Elgin. This is a four bedroom house. The service provided there supports four young adults who have a learning disability and/or autism to live as independently as possible in the community. The people who live there require a high level of support to meet their care needs, including managing some challenging behavior. The staff group provides 24 hour assistance. The service users would not manage without this level of support and this model provides them with as much independence as possible. This is an essential service to meet the needs of the four people who live there.
