The drug and alcohol service aim is to support individuals and families with alcohol and drug problems through substitute prescribing, community detoxification/rehabilitation, 1:1 support, talking therapy (counselling), motivational support, social/psychiatric assessments and working towards recovery based on individually tailored recovery plans, as well as providing advice and support to all affected by drugs and alcohol.

Drug and alcohol services also work in partnership with the following commissioned services - Studio 8 (Turning Point Scotland), Moray Integrated Drug and Alcohol Service (NHS), Moray Council on Addiction and Quarriers.
