<b>Description:</b>  Occupational therapists are integrated and work as part of multi-disciplinary teams, alongside community care officers, in both the adult community care service access and east and west teams. Within community care, occupational therapy also has its own distinct identity with an occupational therapy team manager who has line management responsibility for occupational therapists across the whole of the service.  Occupational therapists are involved in the assessment for services, housing advice on coping with the effects of illness or disability, the provision of equipment and adaptations to assist with daily living tasks.
