## **Description:**

The Accountancy Service provides support to the Council's chief financial officer (Section 95 Officer) to ensure that the Council's financial arrangements are sound. The service provides support for a gross revenue budget of £259 million, a gross capital budget of £62 million and the council's 200 Budget Managers.

The service comprises the following areas:

- Financial Planning (including development of Asset Management Planning )
- Preparation of Statutory Accounts
- Financial Control
  - Budget Monitoring
  - Committee & Other Group attendance and advice
  - Ensuring internal and external regulatory requirements are met
- Financial Management System General Ledger administration and training
- Service and Budget Manager support training and advice
- Statutory, Statistical Returns
- Special Projects e.g. Pathfinder North Broadband, DBS etc
- Financial Services to Other Bodies and Funds e.g. Partnerships, War Vets, Assessors, public Trusts and Common Good funds
- Asset Register administration

## The service is based in the HQ Campus.

## Outcomes / impacts:

- Financial information to support the financial planning process and annual budget.
- Statutory Accounts for the Council and other statutory returns made.
- Monthly budget monitoring statements and other financial information as agreed with budget managers.
- Budget managers and users of the financial system are trained and supported to carry out their jobs.

As a support service, the Accountancy service does not have a direct impact on the achievement of the Council's priorities but it has an important part to play in ensuring that the council operates within a sound financial environment.
