It was noted that work was well under way regarding the flood alleviation scheme at Arradoul.

Members of that community are happy that works are going ahead and hope that this will stop the fear of flooding in area.

It was also noted that nothing as yet had been done regarding the flooding situation at Drybridge- especially the area at Linburn House. Cllr Mrs. A. McKay stated that she draws attention to this fact when possible so that it does not get forgotten. There was a significant sum of money set aside for this work and we would not like it seen to be swallowed up in another project.

Concern has also been noted from residents in Drybridge regarding a new house plot just outside village. The access on to a single track road is situated between two bends in the road and is thought to be a hazard.

Craigmin Cottages

It was suggested that hand rails could be put up at the three sets of steps leading from road/parking area to Craigmin Cottages as it is a safety concern.
