Broom of Moy Bridge Extension

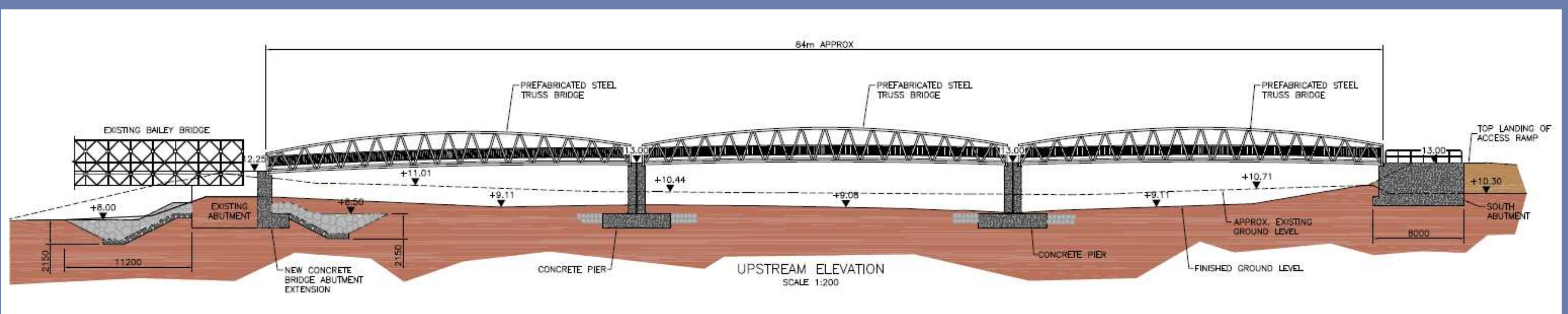
Principles

- The Broom of Moy bridge is being extended to cross the flood water path
- Three new bridge spans will be added onto the existing bridge
- The new spans have been designed to complement the existing Bailey bridge and will be painted in holly bush green
- The length of the bridge closure is being kept to a minimum by building the bridge sections off site, these will then be craned into position
- To tie the existing footpath and Sustrans cycle way in with the end of the extended bridge a short, permanent alteration to the route is required



Construction Works

- The bridge extension works are programmed to take place summer 2013 and last for approximately 21 weeks
- The works require up to a 10 week temporary closure of the bridge towards the end of this construction period during which time a diversion will be in place



Footpaths and Cycle Routes

- The construction works affect a number of footpaths and cycle routes both temporarily and permanently – for more detail please see the slideshow
- To minimise the impact to the general public the affected routes shall be kept open wherever possible and where temporary closures are required diversion routes will be clearly signed
- The length of any closure shall be a maximum of 10 weeks at any one time
