1. PRIOR MINUTES

- (i) The Minutes of the Meeting held on 7 March 2013 were submitted and approved.

2. LIST OF DECISIONS FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PREMISES LICENCES

(i) Application for a Variation to Premises Licence at Keystore, Forres

The Depute Clerk introduced the application and advised he had cited the applicant to attend. The Board agreed to the variation and granted the application.

3. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 – PERSONAL LICENCE APPLICATION HEARING FOLLOWING APPLICATION FOR REVIEW BY THE CHIEF CONSTABLE (CASE NUMBER 7 OF 2013)

The Depute Clerk introduced the application. The licence holder was present. After hearing from the police representative and the licence holder Cllr Cree put forward a motion to endorse licence due to licence holder acting in a manner which is inconsistent with the licensing objectives of preventing crime and disorder and securing public safety but warned if the licence holder appeared before the Board again his decision would not be so lenient. All members agreed.

4. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 – REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCES VARIOUS HEARINGS FOLLOWING THE MAKING OF PREMISES LICENCE REVIEW PROPOSALS

The Depute Clerk updated the Board on matters concerning the two premises noted in the report. Duffus Inn – the annual fee had been paid and the licence transferred. The Board were pleased to hear that it would still be a licensed premises in its rural location. Amoroma – all letters sent to the premises and the licence holder had been returned as undeliverable. Cllr Shepherd moved to revoke the licence and the Board agreed.
