The methodology used is detailed below:

I firstly looked at hotels with the following parameters:

- 1. Filtered on hotels between 10 and 50 bedrooms.
- 2. Removed all surveys at locations south of East/West Midlands and in Southern Ireland.
- 3. Filtered on hotels with low populations in the surrounding area.
- 4. Manually removed Travel Inn in Dundee as it was edge of city centre.

The results shown are mainly free standing out of town (1) or suburban area out of centre (3) hotels. I think this is as close as you will get to specific locations, TRICS is rather sparse on specifically rural examples.

As a comparison (to show restaurant etc) I looked at pub/restaurant with hotels using parameters 1-3 detailed above. As you can see from the results, the trip rates are slightly lower than the hotel alone, probably accounting for a higher proportion of trips by other mode.

One thing that may increase the trip rate though is whether the gym is available for use by people outside the hotel. I have therefore added a quick TRICS report for private fitness centres based on GFA.

The Belmont Hotel is a traditional family run hotel which was opened in the 1950's, popular with both residents and non-residents. This site generates high trip rates per bedroom when compared to others, as many non-residents drive to the hotel for meals and functions (it is popular).

Facilities at the site include 12 en suite bedrooms (5 single, 5 double, and 2 family rooms), a restaurant (open to the public - very popular for lunches, high teas, and dinners, especially at weekends), a night club which is well frequented on Saturday nights, secure car parking with CCTV in operation, and facilities for wedding receptions (up to 250 people) and conferences (up to 350 people - including fax, email, video/tv, etc).

There are 50 full time staff, and these are augmented by varying numbers of part time staff for functions.

Local services are available to/from Lurgan, Portadown, Newry, Rathfriland, and Newcastle, a total of 72 per day (one way). In addition Express bus services between Belfast and Dublin and Belfast and Newry pass through Banbridge. There are a total of 31 (1-way) services daily.
