I have provided a summary of the meeting with Diane Anderson and Richard Geering of Moray Council (MC) Roads Department 19/05/11below.

- MC feel justified in asking for the 10 new passing places and 3 upgrades to existing passing places and at this point are unwavering in this request. There was no further mention of provision of the two lane section from the entrance to the adjacent road.
- Under current planning policy, they have the right to request 1 passing place per dwelling unit.
- Although in the calculation for planning gain assessed the proposed hotel as the equivalent of 3 dwellings, this approach is not one adopted by MC Roads Department.
- There is no standard calculation they use to provide an equivalent of how many dwellings the hotel would be, but they are comfortable that what they are asking is fitting for the size of the development. For instance, the number of parking spaces being provided would equate the hotel to approximately 18 dwellings. Although they would not suggest 18 passing places would be required.
- They have stipulated that they are asking for this provision as they can and they feel it is what is required to bring the road in line with current guidance. It is however, not based on a safety concern relevant to historic accident data.
- The Tullock development was approved prior to the publication of current passing place guidance and has not been required to provide any additional passing places
- MC state that should you wish to proceed on this basis they would prefer works to be completed by you prior to completion of the hotel. Should this not be the case a contribution of £7,590 per passing place would be requested

Further to our telephone conversation yesterday, I am currently awaiting response from Elaine Penny regarding a cost for the accident data. I will chase this further if I have not heard back by lunchtime.


