

Moray Council Unauthorised Encampments CODE OF CONDUCT

You and those living with you must not harass or act in an anti-social manner to any persons in the neighbourhood. Anti-social behaviour means speech, actions or writing which causes another person alarm or distress. This includes damage to their property.

You must also:

- · not overcrowd the site
- park vehicles safely
- · look after the land you park on and respect local residents
- keep pets quiet and under control and don't let them disturb neighbours
- not leave litter or unwanted goods behind you
- dispose of litter and other rubbish in bags or bins provided
- · not fly tip
- use recycling centres for disposal of goods not suitable for bins
- · use portaloos provided
- · comply with the highway code
- · not start fires
- · keep reasonable control of your children

As Gypsies/Travellers you must recognise that you are under the same duty to behave responsibly as members of the settled community. If you breach the Code of Conduct or camp somewhere unsuitable, The Moray Council will take enforcement action against you, including seeking your eviction.

Gypsies/Travellers who are evicted will not be able to return to the encampment for 4 weeks.
