

Forres (River Findhorn & Pilmuir) Flood Alleviation Scheme Flood Embankments

What they do...

The embankments form a barrier between Forres and the flood water from the River Findhorn.

How they do it...

The design of the embankments was chosen to protect Forres from a 1 in 200 year flood. This was calculated by computer modelling of the river and ground water. The embankments will be up to 40m wide at the base.

How they're built...

- → The embankments are constructed using material excavated from the river bends
- → The route of the embankments is cleared and the ground prepared
- → The material is placed in layers. Each layer is compacted
- → Tests and inspections are regularly carried out to ensure the embankments will be strong enough to control the flood waters
- → The embankments will be covered with topsoil and seeded with grass.
