2. LIST OF DECISIONS FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PREMISES LICENCES

(i) Application for a New Premises Licence at Bijou, 8-10 Batchen Street, Elgin

The Depute Clerk introduced the application. The applicant was in attendance and apologised for not being at the last meeting. Depute Clerk advised all paperwork in order therefore the Board agreed to grant.

(ii) Application for a Variation to Premises Licence at Royal Findhorn Yacht Club, Findhorn
