What has happened since the last update?

7 March 2014:

Consultation on the Proposed Moray Local Development Plan commenced.

7 March to 12 March 2014:

Adverts giving notice of the publication appeared in local papers. Several newspapers included articles providing further details at the launch of the Proposed Plan with a focus on proposals local to their area.

7 March to 12 March 2014:

3,700 letters have been sent to occupiers and neighbours of sites proposed for development in the plan. Over the last week the team have been responding to queries resulting from the letters.

Ongoing:

Despite the deadline for responses being 2 May 2014, responses have started to come in and the team have started to review these. We are also preparing for information events being held in April. See below for dates.

How to respond

If you wish to make comments on the Proposed Plan please use the response form available online. These can be completed online or printed off and submitted to us by email or post. Using the response form helps us to know which part of plan you are responding to and what specific change you wish to be made.

What happens to your response

Unresolved representations to the Proposed Plan will be submitted to the Scottish Government for examination. A Reporter examines the issues and representations made and makes a recommendation to the Council on whether the Plan requires to be amended.

We are also consulting on Supplementary Guidance. Responses to Supplementary Guidance will be reviewed by Planning Officers and responses and recommendations reported to the Planning and Regulatory Committee. The Planning and Resources Committee will decide what changes should be made to the Supplementary Guidance as a result of responses.

Information Events

A series of drop-in information events will be held, where the Plan can be viewed, and Planning Officer will be on hand to advise on the proposals and how to respond.
