

UNEMPLOYMENT TRENDS



Note: As of December 2002 'proportion of unemployment' replaced 'unemployment rate'. The proportion of unemployment is a percentage of working age residents who are claimants in an area rather than the previous rate which was based on the percentage of the economically active population.

RECENT TRENDS

Over the last month, unemployment in:



 Moray has risen from 1,111 to 1,072, a decrease of 3.5%



 Scotland has fallen from 110,722, to 105,397, a decrease of 4.8%



UK has fallen from 1,196,269 to 1,142,340 a decrease of 4.5%

Over the past 12 months, unemployment in:



 Moray has fallen from 1,357 to 1,072, a decrease of 21.0%



 Scotland has fallen from 138,039 to 105,397, a decrease of 23.6%



 UK has fallen from 1,538,576 to 1,142,340, a decrease of 25.8%

PROSPECTS



There is usually a decrease in Moray's unemployment total between April and May.



Between 2004 and 2013, the average April - May monthly decrease was 55.



It is possible, therefore, that Moray's unemployment total could fall next month.

AGE AND DURATION

Between March and April (data rounded to nearest 5):

- Long term unemployment (52weeks+) has fallen from 215 to 210
- Youth unemployment (24 years and under) has fallen from 310 to 280
