

UNEMPLOYMENT TRENDS



<u>Note:</u> As of December 2002 'proportion of unemployment' replaced 'unemployment rate'. The proportion of unemployment is a percentage of working age residents who are claimants in an area rather than the previous rate which was based on the percentage of the economically active population.

RECENT TRENDS

Over the last month, unemployment in:



Moray has risen from 999 to 932, a decrease of 6.7%



Scotland has fallen from 101,107, to 97,075, a decrease of 4.0%



UK has fallen from 1,089,976 to 1,020,290 a decrease of 6.4%

Over the past 12 months, unemployment in:

- Moray has fallen from 1,255 to 932, a decrease of 25.3%



- Scotland has fallen from 132,569 to 97,075, a decrease of 26.8%
- UK has fallen from 1,439,782 to 1,020,290, a decrease of 29.1%

PROSPECTS



There is usually a decrease in Moray's unemployment total between June and July.



Between 2004 and 2013, the average June - July monthly decrease was 6.

It is possible, therefore, that Moray's unemployment total could fall next month.

AGE AND DURATION

Between May and June (data rounded to nearest 5):

- Long term unemployment (52weeks+)
 has fallen from 200 to 195
- Youth unemployment (24 years and under) has fallen from 260 to 245
