Item complete.</p> <p>Remains on going. The Mural is to be hung in the Town Hall, Cost of wood for framing will be £64, we await advice from Gordonstoun on coating the painting to protect it from deterioration or damage.</p> <p>Mrs MacMillan gave an update on the current school position. We have 57 pupils in school and 15 in nursery which is now full. Some new school pupils are due before Christmas. Mrs Thomson has been extended as acting head until 19th December while we awaited advertising of the permanent position.</p> <p>Concerns have been raised as eligible children are being turned down for a nursery place because we are at full capacity. There are also concerns regarding availability of places for January nursery entrants.
