

MORAY CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE



The old North East of Scotland Child Protection Committee (NESCPC) is no longer in existence and disbanded in March 2013.

The Child Protection Partnership (CPP) took its place and agreed to carry on 4 key areas of work on a pan Grampian basis (Moray, Aberdeenshire, Aberdeen):

- Operations and Practice
- Significant Case Reviews
- Multi Agency Core Child Protection Training
- Child Protection Register

These areas are jointly funded by agencies in each Local Authority and Police Scotland.

Moray, Aberdeenshire, and Aberdeen all have their own individual Child Protection Committee now. Each Committee also has a Lead Officer for Child Protection and they are:
