# Statutory consultation for rezoning Elgin Primary Schools 2015

### **MORAY COUNCIL IS PROPOSING:**

- (i) To vary the catchment areas of Bishopmill, East End, Greenwards, New Elgin, Seafield and West End primary schools in Elgin based on geographical areas which are delineated on plans contained within the Proposal Paper.
- (ii) To establish a catchment area for a new primary school, including nursery, to serve a delineated geographical area in south-east Elgin.
- (iii) To establish a catchment area for a new primary school, including nursery, to serve a delineated geographical area in north Elgin.
