3. Matters Arising : Fraser welcomed Elaine Davidson and Diane Anderson to the PCC as new members.

Fraser informed PCC that Jim Urquhart and Peter Murray were willing to do the work required to Flagstaff when Peter came back onshore. The PCC will fund materials needed for this operation.

4. Police Matters: No police presence.

Community Warden : Iain stated that one youth had been charged in connection with the anti social behavioural issues which occurred in Haig Street.

Report of damage done to roof of school again youths involved.

Report of youngsters kicking balls at cars in Admiralty Street.

Report of bus shelter window in Church Street smashed. Cllr Shepherd to inform MDC so that it can be repaired.

There has been complaints of persons feeding seagulls and also overloading of bins at caravan park where seagulls have been at work leaving mess.

Iain to look into car parking issues around school, cars parked on pavement meaning children to go onto road to pass causing safety concerns.

Asked regarding legal situation of cars propped up on road, Iain stated as long as road taxed, MOT'd, not leaking oil and causing no obstruction then not causing an offence.

5. Matters for Elected Members :

Cllr Shepherd was asked about potholes still in road. He replied that this was in hand.

He stated that contractor doing work at playing field were paying for the porta loo.

Playing field work still ongoing.

Housing officer from MDC visited site where materials being kept at car parking area off Street and said that site would be used until all roofs were slated.

Bollard sited on road at school has been mended.
