Evaluation Summary

- There was a total of 289 who attended meetings at 7 venues across Moray
- 170 people completed the meeting evaluation questionnaires (59% response rate)
- Some people felt there was too much detailed paper information to digest within the space of the meetings
- The notification of the meetings was too short for some people
- The analysis of the data from the meetings was time consuming and could have been more efficiently gathered e.g. scoring system/pad would have collated the most / least popular responses
- Officer input in all aspects of the initiative was high and could have been more efficiently deployed e.g. a central planning co-ordinator for venues, distribution lists, invitations and publicity
- A shortage of representatives from those who traditionally do not engage was evident e.g. young people
- Many people commented positively that the use of visual presentations aided their understanding of issues
- Many people felt that it was easier to participate in small discussion groups without feeling overwhelmed
