

Moray Council progress report on Community Learning and Development in Bishopmill East and New Elgin East – August 2009

HMIe published a report on the inspection of Community Learning and Development in May 2007. The report can be accessed from the HMIe website (www.hmie.gov.uk). This was reported to Education and Social Services Committee on 22 August 2007. At that time Inspectors required the service and the authority to prepare an action plan indicating how they would address the main points for action identified in the original report.

Progress with Main Points for Action identified by HMIe:-

- Develop strategy for Community Learning and Development staff recruitment to secure sustainable provision in the future.
