In 2006, the Scottish Executive used General Register for Scotland population estimates to calculate the percentage estimates of children for pre-school education. In previous years these estimates were calculated based on the number of children aged 3, 4 or 5 registered as at January in the given year. For this reason, results are not comparable to those published in in previous years.

The percentage of children attending pre-school education in an area can exceed 100% as children may cross local authority boundaries to attend pre-school education or attend more than one centre, and as population figures are estimates the percentages should be treated as estimates and interpreted with caution
