

**REPORT TO: COMMUNITY PLANNING BOARD ON 27 AUGUST 2009**

**SUBJECT: SINGLE OUTCOME AGREEMENT 2008-9 – UNMET ACTIONS**

**1. REASON FOR REPORT**

1.1 The Community Planning Board is asked to note the actions from SOA 2008-9 which will continue to be monitored by the strategic theme groups.

**2. RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 **The Community Planning Board is asked to approve the continuing monitoring of the unmet actions by each of the strategic theme groups as listed in para 3.3**

**3. BACKGROUND**

3.1 At the special Community Planning Board meeting on 10 June 2009, it was agreed that Lead Officers for each of the theme groups would be contacted to consider whether each of the unmet actions within the theme group not contained within the revised SOA or the support local delivery action plans would be continued to be monitored.

3.2 Through the discussion it was agreed that the actions as listed in the table will continue to be monitored at the strategic theme groups, not be monitored or are contained within the SOA. A complete list of the actions is contained in the appendix. **(Appendix)**

3.3 Actions contained within the SOA will be monitored as part of that process. The additional actions to be monitored and theme group responsible for monitoring the actions are listed below. It should be noted that some of the actions to be monitored may now sit with a different theme group than for the original action.

Consultations have taken place with the relevant theme group lead officers who have identified the actions to continue to monitor and the Performance Management & Quality Assurance Officer who will be working with the Lead Officers to gather the monitoring information.
