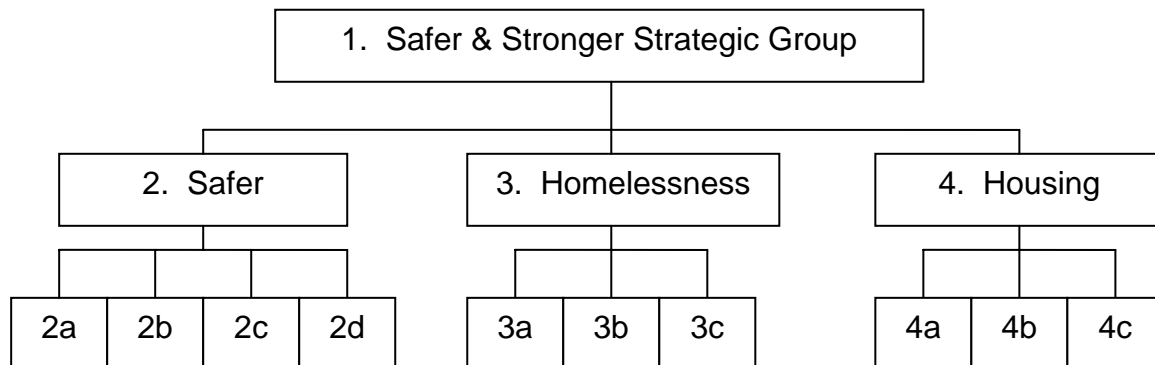

### **3a. Temporary, Supported and Permanent Accommodation**

#### Remit

This group's remit is to oversee the implementation of the Temporary Accommodation Strategy and specifically to ensure the availability of sufficient and appropriate accommodation to meet the needs of homeless households. It also informs housing mix on new Council and RSL developments.

### **3b. Support Services & Vulnerable Adults**

#### Remit

This Group was originally formed to map the current provision of support services to Homeless people in Moray, to develop agreements (including the implementation of a specialist Homelessness Single Shared Assessment) between agencies to ensure the availability of and access to services and to consider the development of projects and initiatives that will assist in meeting identified gaps in services including: information, advice, and education services and; training and employment opportunities. It has not met for some time.

A proposal will be made to both the LHS group and the Homelessness Strategy Group that this group is amended to provide a Community Care and Health input to the development and implementation of both the LHS and the Homelessness

Strategies. It is proposed that this working group will be re-titled Housing, Community Care and Health.

Membership

**3c. Homelessness Prevention and Advice & Information**

Remit

To ensure that an appropriate range of information and advice resources and services are available to meet the needs of homeless households, to ensure that existing information and advice services are accessible to homeless households. It is also proposed that this remit be extended to specifically consider prevention and advice services for young people, given the proposed deletion of the Young People and Support Group.

Membership

To be determined following the Homelessness Strategy Group meeting in February 2010.

**Young People & Support**

Remit

Originally, this group was established to map the current provision of Homelessness services to young people and to develop service level agreements for the delivery of these services. The Group has essentially completed these tasks, therefore its continued operation is not seen as necessary. This will be confirmed in discussion with partner organisations at the next Homelessness Strategy Group meeting in February 2010.

**4. Housing Strategy (LHS) Group**

Remit

The Housing Strategy Group’s remit covers the development of the Local Housing Strategy. The LHS is the overarching strategic statement for all aspects of housing. The Group also monitors the implementation of the LHS and considers innovations/initiatives in housing development. The group receives reports from the working groups below.

The Group currently meets once every six months. However, with the requirement to develop a LHS in accordance with revised guidelines from the Scottish Government, the Group will be reviewing its remit as a Housing Market Partnership as required by the LHS guidance in the preparation of the Housing Needs and Demand Assessment.

#### **4c. Support & Care**
