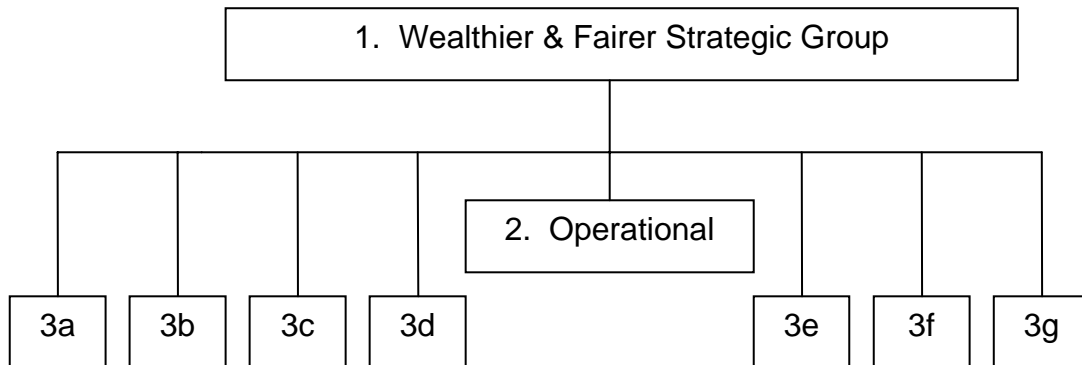

Remit
