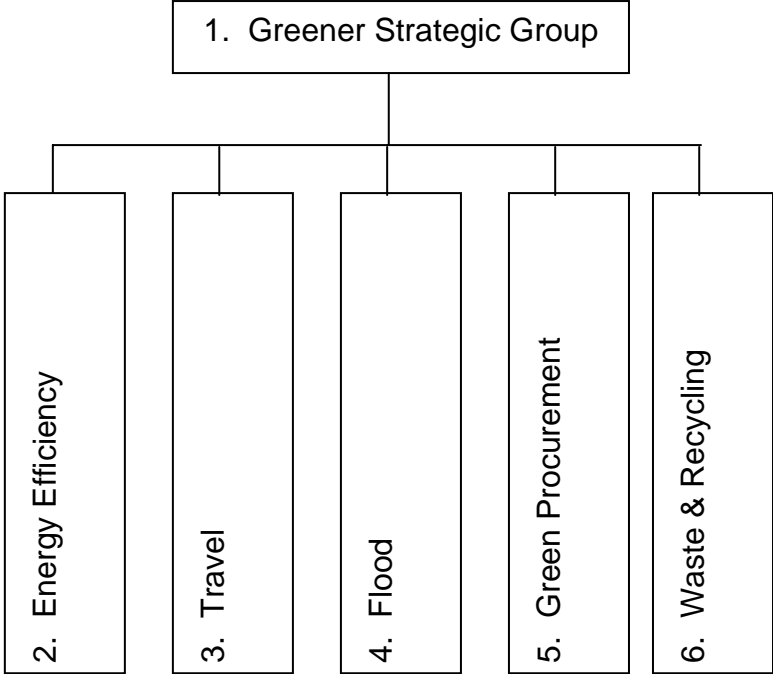


Review of Greener Operational Groups

Operational Groups

The Greener Operational groups have been decided based on the key actions from their Local Delivery Action Plan. Each key action will fit under one of the 5 operational groups and it will be the operational group's job to ensure these actions are being carried out. The Lead Officer of the strategic group will appoint a lead to each of the operational groups and these leads will submit reports to each Greener Strategic Group meeting on their progress with their specific key actions. Once a lead is established for each operational group, the members of that group will then be decided on.
