## **Summary of Health & Social Care Services Committee functions:**

To exercise all the functions of the Council as Education Authority; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Children (Scotland) Act 1995 in conjunction with the Community Services Committee; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act 1973; to deal with the appointment, transfer, dismissal, suspension, remuneration and conditions of teaching staff so far as under the control of the Council, subject to the duty of the Policy and Resources Committee to co-ordinate and apply local conditions of service of teaching staff after the approval of the Education Committee and to assist voluntary organisations, work with school boards, provide adult education services, the provision of community centres and sporting facilities.

To exercise the functions of the Council as Social Work Authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968; to exercise the functions of the Council under Part X of the Children Act 1989; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984; to exercise the functions of the Council under the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947 and the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Children (Scotland) Act 1955 in conjunction with the Educational Services Committee
