To exercise the functions of the Council as Social Work Authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968; to exercise the functions of the Council under Part X of the Children Act 1989; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Mental Health (Care and Treatment)(Scotland) Act 2003 to exercise the functions of the Council under the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947 and the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990; to exercise the functions of the Council under the Children (Scotland) Act 1995; to exercise the Council's powers to contribute to the expense of housing elderly, infirm or disabled people; to exercise control of expenditure of available funds in Social Work Trusts; to exercise the function of the Council in respect of services to adults with incapacity in terms of the Adults with Incapacity (Scotland) Act 2000; to deal with all adult protection issues, including domestic abuse and to implement the Council's responsibilities with regard to criminal justice, social work services.
