SUBJECT: ROLE AND REMIT OF THE HEALTHIER STRATEGIC GROUP

1. REASON FOR REPORT

- 1.1 To invite the Healthier Strategic Group to agree the role and remit for the group based on the Single Outcome Agreement (SOA) and other commitments.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 **It is recommended that the Healthier Strategic Group agree the role of the Healthier Strategic Group based on the Single Outcome Agreement (SOA) and other commitments. (A copy of the Moray Community Health & Social Care Role and Remit document is attached at Appendix 1).**

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Under the terms of the terms of the existing Partnership Agreement the Moray Community Health and Social Care Partnership was formed in April 2005 and Government policy directed that NHS boards and local authorities had to form partnership bodies to fulfil core and joint statutory functions for health and social care. Moray Council and NHS Grampian constituted the Moray Health and Social Care Partnership to fulfil these functions.
- 3.2 In light of recent legislative changes by the Scottish Government the Moray Council undertook a review of its Community Planning Structure and agreed to the formation of a Community Planning Board,

Community Engagement group and five Theme Groups of which this group is one to ensure that all public agencies in Moray were in a position to deliver the Single Outcome Agreement required by the government.
