4.2.1 Tracey Gervaise MCHSCP Public Health Lead has highlighted that many of the priority actions have medium to long-term timescales. As such many of the quarter 2 updates replicate those for quarter 1.

4.2.2 A request has been received to remove the action 'Develop housing/support models for older people in their communities', as this is not an action identified in the current Community Services Service Improvement Plan. However at the Special Community Planning Board meeting on 27 November it was agreed that the removal of any actions had to be approved by the Board with the reason for its removal. This is due to the requirement by Scottish Government to produce a report against all commitments contained in the Single Outcome Agreement.
