

### Integrated Inspections – Pre-Schools

Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMIE) and the Care Commission published 2 Integrated Inspection Reports in relation to pre-school centres within Moray.

Pre-School Centres undergo an annual inspection. In the current 3-year cycle of inspection, 2 of these will be a Singleton Inspection by the Care Commission and one will be an Integrated Inspection by HMIE jointly with the Care Commission.

Reports contain Recommendations, which are intended to support improvements in the quality of service. Any Requirements refer to actions, which must be taken by service providers to ensure that regulations are met and there is compliance with relevant legislation.
