

## APPENDIX 1 Existing Demand for Allotments

### Forres Transition Town

Following the establishment of the Community Garden at Bogton Road Forres the group have a growing waiting list of 98 people interested in allotments and the group are anxious to identify further land. This demand would increase if more land was made available.

### Elgin Allotment Association

27 people have joined paid this was achieved without publicity or an established site. They have been trying to identify a variety of sites with little success.

### Keith Allotment Association

This group is now constituted and has a database of 38 people wishing to have an allotment. They have expressed interest in Council owned land which sits below Quarryhill Road in Keith.

### Cullen Community Allotment Association

This group is now constituted and has a database of 20 people wishing to have an allotment. They have expressed interest in land owned by the Lawtie Trust on the Lintmill Road just outside Cullen.

### Dufftown Allotment Group

Group not constituted as yet, but may be represented by Community Association. They have a database of 12 people wishing to have an allotment. They have looked at land behind council houses in Church Street, Dufftown, which were previously part of the council gardens.

### Fochabers Allotment group

Has recently established and has in the region of 20 people interested. They are investigating some options on private land, Crown Estate.

### Lhanbryde

There is a new group which has 7 people who are organising the establishment of a group in Lhanbryde.

### **Potential Demand**

There has been noted interest in Hopeman and there is the likelihood of a group being developed. There is increasing interest across Moray and where land is made available, as shown in Forres, the demand for allotments will increase.
